Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica

Today the Church celebrates the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica, the cathedral of the Bishop of Rome and the “Mother and Head of all Churches in the world.” Built by Emperor Constantine and entrusted to the ministry of St. John the Baptist and St. John the Evangelist, this basilica reminds us that our faith is rooted in a living history and a living Church.

The readings today turn our eyes toward the true Temple of God. In Ezekiel’s vision, a river flows from the Temple bringing life wherever it goes, even transforming the Dead Sea. This river points to the grace of God flowing from Christ and His Church, especially through the sacraments. Wherever God’s grace reaches, barren places become alive again.

Saint Paul reminds us that Christ is the only foundation on which the Church stands. He also tells us that we ourselves are God’s temple, because the Holy Spirit lives within us. Our lives, our choices, and the way we treat one another either build up this holy dwelling or harm it.

In the Gospel, Jesus cleanses the Temple, calling His Father’s house back to purity. His words point to a deeper truth: the new and everlasting Temple is His own Body, risen and alive.

Today we are invited to let Christ cleanse our hearts, renew our love for the Church, and help us worship God with sincerity. May our parish be a place where grace flows, healing grows, and every person finds life in Christ.
