When we give, we often expect something in return praise, favours, or repayment. But real love is selfless. Jesus invites us to a deeper generosity: "When you hold a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind." This is a call to serve those who cannot repay us, to love without conditions, to be Christ to those in need. As followers of Jesus. let us embrace humility in a world that often prizes pride, and let us choose generosity that expects no reward. Our repayment will not be in earthly recognition, but in eternal joy: "You will be repaid at the resurrection of the righteous." True greatness lies in serving others with love. Fr Jithin Jose
