19th Sunday ~ In today's Gospel (Luke 12:32-48), Jesus tells us, "Do not be afraid, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom." These words are filled with hope. Our Lord reminds us that God's desire is not to punish or condemn, but to bless and save.

Jesus speaks about being ready—keeping our lamps lit and our hearts open. Hope is what keeps that light burning. Without hope, our faith can grow dim, and our love can grow cold. But when we live in hope, we trust that God is working even in our struggles, and that His promises will be fulfilled.

This year, as a parish, we have been journeying together through moments of joy and challenge. We have celebrated new beginnings and mourned losses. We have faced uncertainties in our world, but hope has kept us moving forward. Today's Gospel calls us to deepen that hope—not just as a vague feeling, but as a way of living.

Hope means believing that even if the night is long, the dawn will come. It means serving faithfully in the present because we trust in God's future. It means caring for one another, sharing our blessings, and not losing sight of the eternal home prepared for us.

As we reflect on this Sunday's message, let us be that "little flock" who walks without fear, because we know the Shepherd who leads us is faithful. Let our readiness not be one of anxiety, but of joyful expectation—living every day as if the Master might knock at our door at any moment, and finding us with lamps burning brightly in hope.
