Keep Praying, Keep Believing ~ In today's Gospel, Jesus tells the story of a poor widow who refuses to give up her plea for justice. Though the judge is unjust and indifferent, she persists until he finally listens. At first glance, it's a simple story about persistence but beneath it lies a message about faith, endurance, and trust in God's timing. Jesus tells this parable while walking toward Jerusalem toward His passion, death, and resurrection. His disciples are anxious and uncertain about the future. Through this story, Jesus reassures them and us, that faith is not a feeling but a steady perseverance, even when God seems silent. Like Moses who kept his hands raised in prayer during Israel's battle, the widow reminds us to "pray always without becoming weary." Faith is not passive waiting; it's active hope. The widow's persistence flows from her conviction that her cause is just. Likewise, our prayers should spring from the deep belief that God's cause our salvation is good and true. When Jesus asks, "Will the Son of Man find faith on earth?", it is not to frighten us but to awaken us. He reminds us that faith must be kept alive through constant prayer, humility, and hope, especially when we face injustice, suffering, or doubt. May the example of this humble widow inspire us to keep praying, keep believing, and keep trusting until the Lord returns and finds faith alive in our hearts.
