Who Is My Neighbour? A Call to Compassion ~ In today's Gospel, Jesus shares the Parable of the Good Samaritan — a powerful story that challenges us to rethink who our neighbour truly is. When asked, "Who is my neighbour?" Jesus doesn't give a simple definition but tells of a Samaritan, an outsider, who shows mercy and compassion to a wounded man, while religious leaders pass by.

This parable reminds us that our neighbour is not just someone nearby or like us — it is anyone in need. It is the stranger, the lonely, the vulnerable among us. True faith calls us to step beyond comfort and ritual, to "get off the donkey," and care for those who suffer.

Pope Francis describes the Church as a "field hospital," a place where mercy is freely given and all are welcomed. Our faith is shown not in words alone but in loving actions — caring for the forgotten, bandaging wounds, and offering hope.

As St. James reminds us, "Religion that is pure is to care for those in distress." Let us answer Jesus' call: "Go and do likewise." May our parish be known not only for what we say but for how we love — reaching out with open hearts to our neighbours, whoever they may be.

Let's reflect this week: Who have I passed by? Whose wounds can I help heal? Together, let us live the compassion that redefines boundaries.
